

Over Five Million Californians' Coverage At Risk Under ACA Repeal: Data by Congressional District

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Over five million Californians directly rely on the health resources provided by the **Affordable Care Act (ACA)** either by gaining coverage through the **Medicaid (Medi-Cal) expansion**, or receiving financial assistance to buy private health insurance through **Covered California**. ACA repeal proposals, such as the American Health Care Act (AHCA) that the GOP House passed on May 4th 2017, would not just threaten these gains, but fundamentally change a 50-year federal and state Medicaid funding partnership shifting hundreds of billions in costs to states. These proposals, including the still-pending Graham-Cassidy legislation, functionally eliminate Medicaid expansion funding and cut federal funding for premium subsidies for those that buy their coverage in Covered California, forcing many to pay much more for far less coverage. Passage of any of these proposals would result in millions of consumers being left in a smaller and sicker insurance pool and facing skyrocketing premiums. **This chart details ACA program enrollment by California Congressional district with the most recent available 2017 Medi-Cal member estimates and 2016 Covered California enrollees.** The chart does not quantify the people with pre-existing conditions or other patients benefiting from ACA consumer protections that are also at risk in these proposals.
